



The Scholarship Program provides financial support to students who are excelling in maritime studies in college or graduate school and to high school seniors who are interested in pursuing such studies.

Top one-time Scholarship Awards ranging from \$7,500 to \$10,000 are paid directly to schools as tuition reimbursement Scholarships. Each year multiple one-time Scholarship Awards ranging from \$1,000 - \$5,000 are also awarded and made payable directly to the student.

All applications are reviewed by the CMA Education Foundation Scholarship Committee and awards are approved by the Board of Directors.

Winners will be based on quality of essay or video submission, academic achievement, faculty reference and those who best demonstrate their interest in a career in the maritime industry. For the top scholarship awards applicants may be invited for an interview via Zoom.

Students who receive awards are permitted to apply again if eligibility requirements are met.

Eligible Students:

- Undergraduate and graduate school students in the United States at maritime academies (including deck, engine, logistics, non-regimental or non-license students) or at colleges and universities that have maritime related degree programs.
- High school students enrolled in schools in the United States with maritime related programs.
- Students in their final year of high school or college if they are pursuing a maritime related education or career upon completion of their current program.
- Maritime professionals who are continuing their education while working in the maritime industry.

Process:

- **All submissions of files, videos and/or photos should be titled with the student's first and last name.**
- **Applications must include:**
 1. **Application form,**
 2. **website/press release form,**
 3. **an original non-AI generated essay or alternatively a video essay, answering one of the specified questions,**
 4. **one reference letter from a faculty member,**
 5. **a resume,**
 6. **picture of the applicant, please label photo with first and last name.**
- **Completed applications should be submitted to Beth Wilson-Jordan at Beth@cma-edu.org any time on or before 11:00 AM EST Sunday, March 9, 2025.**
- **Applications are reviewed by the CMA EF Scholarship Committee, interviews scheduled and conducted as needed, and awards approved by the Board of Directors.**
- **Recipients are notified and awards announced and distributed by June 2025.**

Alternatively, students may submit a video essay, in lieu of the written essay, answering one of the questions below. Videos should not exceed 4 minutes in length and be submitted to Beth@cma-edu.org with a YouTube link. Videos should be titled with student first and last name.

High School Students:

1. What inspires and interests you about the maritime industry? Why do you want to pursue it as a course of study?

College Students:

1. How can the use of technology enhance or make your maritime education more engaging?
2. In what area of the maritime industry do you see yourself contributing to after graduation and why?

Graduate Students:

1. In what area of the maritime industry do you see yourself contributing to and why?
2. How can the use of technology enhance or make your maritime graduate studies more engaging?

Students Who Have Received a Prior CMA EF Scholarship:

Students who have received a previous CMA EF scholarship award are asked in addition to their written or video essay above, to send a separate short video (2 minutes or less) and/or a written testimonial on what your previous scholarship meant to you and how it helped. **Please title submissions with first and last name.**
